What it is

The IPERION HS Doctoral Summer Schools (HS-DSS) are part of the IPERION HS Academy and provide a learning multidisciplinary interactive experience in the field of Heritage Science. Each year HS-DSS are organized by different institutions on different topics. Theoretical and technical lectures are imparted by a wide range of international experts in the field of Heritage Science to provide an overview of the state-of-the-art as well as specific details of their topic.

In particular, the 1st HS-DSS is aimed at providing examples of excellence in Heritage Science for conservation and collection care research and access. The HS-DSS will be taught online and comprise four intensive days of lectures and virtual study visits, during which participants will become acquainted with the multidisciplinary skills of the IPERION HS consortium and knowledge accumulated by the partners.

Lectures and virtual study tours will be adapted to an interdisciplinary audience of learners by focusing more on problem solving than on the specific adopted scientific methods/techniques.



For whom

The 1st online HS-DSS is open to postgraduate, PhD students, post-docs and practitioners, in particular to early career researchers involved in Heritage Science studies. It is particularly suitable for the potential users of the IPERION HS TransNational access (TNA) program. It will highlight the importance of access to large and medium scale facilities, mobile laboratories and data archives within a European dimension.

Participants should be motivated to actively participate and be available for the whole duration of the Summer School. All the sessions will be conducted in English. Therefore, fluency in written and spoken English is essential. A certificate of attendance will be provided to all the participants.

Online event

The HS-Doctoral Summer School will be held online by using the Zoom platform.

Schedule

Lectures will start on Tuesday, July 13th at 9am CET and will end on Friday, July 16th at 5pm CET.

A detailed HS-DSS programme will be available by the end of April 2021.

Doctoral Summer School Fees

No registration fee is required. The admitted participants will be provided with slides of the lecturers' presentations and PDF files of related publications.

Registration

Registered participants will be selected by the HS-DSS Scientific Committee based on their merits, educational and research background and other criteria. Early applications will be given priority. The application deadline is June 18th, 2021. Selected participants will be informed of their acceptance by June 30th, 2021.
