E-RIHS is the European Research Infrastructure for Heritage Science, that supports public and private researchers and professionals by delivering integrated access to the most advanced techniques and facilities to support cultural heritage research and improve its interpretation, enhancement and conservation interventions, in a cross-disciplinary context in which natural sciences and humanities complement each other.

E-RIHS is currently formalizing into a European Research Infrastructure Consortium (ERIC), an international organization with legal personality, whose headquarters will be hosted at the Manifattura Tabacchi in Florence, Italy.

The event represents the opportunity to present what has been done so far and highlight the future steps. This will be discussed by representatives of the academia, research community, cultural heritage protection, businesses and society during a round table.

From October 10 to 14, it is possible to visit the "Brancacci POV", a virtual installation set up at the Manifattura Tabacchi, which monitors the conservation status of the frescoes of the Brancacci Chapel in the church of Santa Maria del Carmine in Florence.

The virtual visit (lasting 45 minutes) will lead visitors through the discovery of what is hidden in the material and in the art of this work thanks to the analyses carried out with the portable instruments of the E-RIHS Italian node, coordinated by CNR.

Brancacci POV was developed by the CNR ISPC Digital Heritage Innovation Lab, with the collaboration of the Municipality of Florence, the Opificio delle Pietre Dure, the Superintendence of Archeology, Fine Arts and Landscape of the Metropolitan City of Florence and the provinces of Pistoia and Prato, and thanks to funding from Friends of Florence and the Jay Pritzker Foundation.
